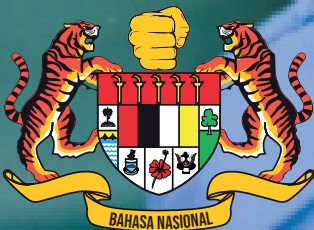
Key Information
